

# Care Instructions



Congratulations on your purchase from The Comfort Shop's range of quality products. To ensure many years of comfort and enjoyment from your purchase, please follow these simple care instructions.

## RECLINER CHAIRS AND LOUNGES

- Do not sit on the foldout footrest section of the Lafer recliner chairs, as this may not support your full body weight
- Make sure the chair is sitting on level flooring to avoid tipping
- Remove any marks using a clean damp cloth
- Leather care kits can be used on our recliners

## LATEX MATTRESSES

- Always place your mattress on the correct bed base. Latex mattresses must be placed on a slat base or a base which allows ventilation around the mattress. The slats on the bed base must not be spaced more than 7cm apart
- We recommend using a mattress protector with your mattress, even if it comes complete with a removable cover. This will absorb moisture before it reaches the mattress and extend the life of your mattress
- Rotate (end-for-end) one month and turn over your mattress the next month to ensure even wear on both sides
- Do not expose mattress to dampness or moisture.
- We recommend periodically vacuum cleaning your mattress. This will ensure you are sleeping in a clean environment, which will promote good health

## VISCO ELASTIC MATTRESSES

- Always place your mattress on the correct bed base. Visco Elastic mattresses must be placed on a slat base or a base which allows ventilation around the mattress. The slats on the bed base must not be spaced more than 7cm apart
- We recommend using a mattress protector with your mattress, even if it comes complete with a removable cover. This will absorb moisture before it reaches the mattress and extend the life of your mattress
- There is no need to rotate or turn over Visco Elastic mattresses; they have a distinct top and bottom side. Please make sure the labels on the side of the mattress are facing up.
- Do not expose mattress to dampness or moisture
- We recommend periodically vacuum cleaning your mattress. This will ensure you are sleeping in a clean environment, which will promote good health

## REMOVABLE MATTRESS COVERS

- Follow the cleaning instructions on the tag carefully for those mattresses that have removable cotton or cotton and wool blend mattress covers
- While you are able to wash the removable mattress covers, we do recommend dry cleaning due to their bulky size when removed from the mattress
- We recommend using a thin 100% cotton mattress protector (available from The Comfort Shop); this will ensure the elasticity of your mattress is not affected, unlike thicker padded mattress protectors

## BED BASES – FLAT & MANUAL ADJUSTABLE

- Do not stand or jump on the slats
- Do not use an 'EBAC flat metal frame' as a freestanding base. The flat metal frames are designed to be installed inside a bed surround. (EBAC electric adjustable metal beds are freestanding)
- If you are installing one of our bases inside your own bed surround, ensure you have the correct side and centre supports
- Do not try to disassemble slats from the frame as individual parts could be damaged in the process
- Do not sit on the foot or head of the bed while it is raised, as this will put too much pressure on the slats

## BED BASES – ELECTRIC ADJUSTABLE

(in addition to those above):

- Do not try to detach the motor from the base
- Keep the motor free from water or moisture

## WALLBEDS

- Ensure your wall bed is installed by a qualified person and that the installation instructions provided are adhered to
- Do not use excessive force when opening or closing your wall bed as this may damage the wall bed unit
